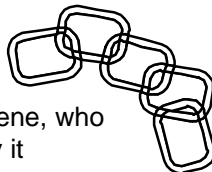

## LAY DIRECTORS' LINK



"And as they led Him (Jesus) away, they seized one Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, and laid on him the cross, to carry it behind Jesus." Luke 23:26.

Two lessons we can glean from Simon's encounter with Jesus. Even though Simon may have been distracted by the weight of this rough cross, his eyes and attention needed to be fixed on the one he was following, namely Jesus.

So often in our personal lives we become distracted, take our eyes off of Jesus, and attempt to carry our cross alone. We may even try to go around the cross to the resurrection.

This is not reality. The series of crosses placed before us is reality. The cross may be a child not practicing his or her christian faith; a chemically dependant family member; tension at home or work; or the innumerable crosses we collectively carry.

With God's help we can grow to be better persons, willingly carry our cross. Let us be prepared, as we carry that cross to encounter the crucified one.

Jesus assures us that He is always there to help our burden. "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy burdened, and I will give you rest." Matthew 28.

Simon also illustrates the necessity for us to be aware of those around us, in our environments. The Lord may be calling us to help others carry their cross just as Simon helped carry Jesus' cross.

Prior to and during the weekends of #255 and #256, this cursillo community overwhelmingly supported these candidates with prayer and sacrifice, prayed that their hearts would be open to receive the abundant life Jesus promised.

We encourage your continued prayers for these new Cursillistas as they begin grouping and attending Ultreya. Let us pray that their lives and the life of Cursillo may become one in Christ Jesus to the glory of our heavenly Father.

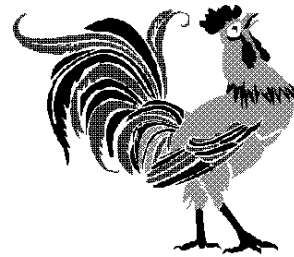
