LAY DIRECTORS' LINK

"If you want to be perfect, go and sell all you have and give the money to the poor, and you will have riches in heaven: then come and follow me."
Matthew 20:21

Twelve men and women from the Twin Cities Cursillo traveled to the Regional meeting in Wichita, Kansas in April. We had a workshop on "Commitment in Cursillo". We talked about "what is commitment"? Is it a promise or is it an obligation? As Fr. Frank Salmani says in his book, Whom Shall I Send, "too often we see commitment to God or Church as a free choice, and at one level it is. God does not force us to follow him. We are free to accept or reject his invitation. It is up to God and the Church to set the conditions for being a disciple, apostle or leader. At baptism, we were given a calling, a vocation. That calling is to be Christ's disciples, to proclaim the good news and share in the prayer, worship and sacrificial life of the Church"

And, "If we say yes to the work of a Cursillo leader we must be serious about our commitment to Jesus. Only Jesus has the words of everlasting life".

How does commitment apply to the Cursillo movement? 1st, Group reunion - The very basic of all tools. This provides the individual Cursillistas with a reliable source of inspiration, growth, challenge and support. 2nd, Ultreya - The community of Cursillistas.

The Ultreya provides each Cursillistas the realization that they belong to a much larger community. 3rd, School of Leaders - This is where the Cursillistas develops a deeper understanding of the Church and the Cursillo movement. 4th, Secretariat - This is the place of responsibility for all aspects of the Cursillo movement. 5th, Regional activities -

This provides an even larger community and occasion for service. 6th, National activities - Where Cursillistas connect with other Cursillistas from throughout the U.S.A. This is where you share ideas, successes, failures and dreams.

We then discussed at the Regional meeting our obstacles that prevent our committing to Cursillo. They are time, organization, motivation, personal, family, communication, work, money etc. We all have reasons or excuses for not committing to Cursillo, sometimes we need to ask, what is mine? These are the times we need to remember, Jesus asks us to give up our possessions and follow Him.

Fr. Bill Martin has invited all of us to join him June 1st, at Guardian Angels at 11AM mass, coffee and cake to follow, and help him celebrate his 25th Anniversary of his priesthood.

We have been notified by National Cursillo that the Pilgrimage to Spain that was originally scheduled for October 2003 has been changed to March 2004. Let us know if you would like to join us in Cincinnati in July for the 13th National Encounter.

Last reminder, please don't forget to join us June 22nd at our Family Cursillo Picnic at Cleary Lake Park in Prior Lake.
