## LAY DIRECTORS' LINK

**The greatest among you must be your Servant.**

**Matthew 23:11**

On October 4th, the Burnses, Pressellers, Stewarts and Mike Moren drove to David City, Nebraska for the Regional Meeting/Workshop. Our workshop was on the School of Leaders. Father Jim Tigges from Iowa gave the talk on the "Spirituality of a Leader". Father Jim has been our Regional Spiritual Director for several years, but is now retiring from this service.

He reminded us that as the early Christians were given the "Spirit of a Leader" at Pentecost, we also were given the "Spirit of a Leader" at our Cursillo weekend. He described the virtues of a Leader as this:

- 1) A leader should have a lively curiosity - have an interest in everything.
- 2) A leader should have a genuine interest in other people - to be able to do this a leader needs to be at peace with him or herself.
- 3) A leader must have an attitude that there will be risks.
- 4) A leader should realize that crisis are normal.
- 5) A leader should have unwarranted optimism.
- 6) A leader should have a sense of personal responsibility for the outcome of his or her efforts.
- 7) A leader should be aware that paranoia and self-pity are not leadership qualities.

As is Matthew 23: We as Christians have a Servant role - balancing ministry with meditation or contemplation (listening to the Lord). Jesus gives us the best example of "Servant Leadership". We all tend to imitate those we admire, and having Jesus as a model enables us to live more fully as Christians. As people of faith in Cursillo we are Leaders - we encourage and invite all to our Leader's School a/k/a School of Leaders of the 1st Tuesday of every month.

Speaking of leaders, we would like to thank Steve Williams and Bill Olson, Sr. for all they do behind the scenes to make the Cursillo weekends go smoothly.

Formation is well underway for weekends No. 245 and 246 at St. Marks in Shakopee. The weekends will begin November 14th for the Men and November 21st for the Women.

Also, please remember to come to the Grand Ultreya, Nov. 7th at the Basilica of St. Mary. A witness talk will be given by Kate Soucheray and Archbishop Flynn will celebrate the mass.
